

Pestilence Fair Project - EVALUATION (How you will be graded)

This project is worth 10% of your final course grade.

Pestilence Fair Exhibit: 50% of project grade

Overall appearance of display, including neatness, organization, attractiveness, correct spelling and grammar	15 points
Accuracy and comprehensive nature of information presented	15 points
Creativity	15 points
Attendance at display, answering questions *****	5 points

***** All students are expected to be present at the Pestilence Fair for the entire 1 hour and 20 minutes of class time on May 6. You should plan your time with your group members so that the exhibit is supervised by 2 students at all times, yet each group member should have an opportunity to visit all other displays during the 1 hour and 20 minute period.

FAQ document: 50% of project grade

Overall appearance of FAQ sheet – neat/professional	15 points
Accuracy and comprehensive nature of the information presented	25 points
Spelling and Grammar	10 points

Peer evaluation:

Each member of the group will be asked to honestly evaluate the overall contributions of each other member of the group, anonymously, on a 1-10 scale. The evaluation you receive from your group members will be averaged and used as a factor. Here is a sample of how this will be used to calculate your final project grade.

Example:

Exhibit: earns 45 points

FAQ: earns 45 points

If you earned 10 points on the peer evaluation:

Project grade (90) x 100% = 90

If you earned 8 points on the peer evaluation:

Project grade (90) x 80% = 72

If you earned 6 points on the peer evaluation:

Project grade (90) x 60% = 54
